DEPUTATION NO. 2:

Considered a deputation from FETSU regarding Students' Union Election in Jadavpur University.

Contents of the Deputation:

Madam/Sir,

Subject: Demands regarding Students' Union Election in Jadavpur University We, the students of Faculty of Engineering and Technology have not had any election for the students' union held since 2020. Despite repeatedly clamouring for an election since 31st December 2021, the authority has failed to comply and not paid any heed to this demand. On 24th December 2022, the students met with the Chancellor and conveyed their demands to him as well.

Most of the students and elected representatives in the last election, held in 2020, have graduated since then, resulting in the students facing continued difficulties in exercising their democratic rights. Furthermore, it has hampered the academic and non-academic activities and pursuits of the students, the onus of which should be shouldered by the authority.

Under these circumstances, we have repeatedly demanded the university administration to hold a students' union election and submitted multiple deputations regarding it since 2021. However, the university administration is yet to take any action in this regard. Hence we put forward the following demands-

- 1) To consider this situation and arrange for a students' union election to be held as early as possible so that the students can exercise their democratic rights.
- 2) We demand that the Executive Council has to resolute that they will conduct students' union election as early as possible, and will take necessary steps for that. Additionally, all the steps taken by the former in this regard have to be conveyed to the students in complete transparency.
- 3) A tripartite meeting to be arranged at the earliest, between the government, authority and the students, to discuss the matter at hand.

Resolved that the Executive Council [EC] received deputations from students unions and students organisations demanding immediate conduct of Students' Union Elections. The EC strongly endorses the demand of the students.

It is noted that the EC in its meeting on 12 November 2022 resolved that:

"The Executive Council feels the necessity of Students' Union Election as the terms of most of the office bearers has expired. Based on this, EC feels that Students' Union Election should be organized if the consent is received from the Government. In this direction, the Executive Council empowers Vice Chancellor to write letter to the Government regarding Students' Union Election."

The Pro-Vice Chancellor in his letter dated 16 November 2022 drew the attention of the State Government to the need of the Students' Union Election, referring the EC decisions.

The Vice Chancellor in his letter dated 07 December 2022 further drew the attention of the State Government to the need of the Students' Union Election, referring to Pro-Vice Chancellors letter.

The EC, in its meeting on 28 December 2022, notes that the University is yet to receive a response from the State Government which is hampering the democratic rights and practices of the students, leading to discontent in the University. The EC now reiterates its stand regarding the holding of the Students' Union Election at the earliest and requests the State Government to accord necessary permission, in terms of clause-3(2)(1) of the Government Notification No.:168-ILC/OM-34L /2017 dated 07.06.2017.

The EC authorizes the Vice Chancellor to intimate the State Government about the resolutions of the Executive Council. The EC also authorizes the Pro Vice Chancellor, Prof. C. Bhattacharyya, to pursue the matter with the State Government in any manner, as he deems fit.

DEPUTATION NO. 3:

Deputation from Forum for Students with Disabilities (FSD) regarding immediate hand over of all equipments and formerly HEPSN building to the CPD.

Contents of the Deputation:

Respected Sir,

With deep concern we found that, the resolution taken by the executive council of Jadavpur University on 10th September 2022 about the transfer of all disability related equipment from the centre for cultural studies and wellbeing to Centre for Persons with Disabilities including the accessible building of formerly HEPSN is not implemented till date. It is three months over, there is no positive initiative from the side of concerned authority about the resolution.

We came to know that Mr. Manajit Mandal, the joint coordinator of the centre for cultural studies and wellbeing is still unwilling to leave the HEPSN building showing some silly reason.

Under this circumstances we strongly demand that, all equipment and the accessible building which was constructed with the fund of UGC for disabled persons must be handed over immediately to the Centre for Persons with Disabilities within 30th December 2022. Otherwise we will be bound to go for a greater movement from 3rd January 2023 that is the 2nd day of convocation of the university.

We hope you will do the needful in this regard with an immediate effect.

DEPUTATION NO. 4:

Deputation from Jadavpur university research Scholars' Association (JURSA) regarding various issues.

Contents of the Deputation:

1. Our demand is the initiation and functioning of an active Placement cell dedicated for the scholars for opting various career opportunities in different sectors.
2. Our demand is a Drug-free campus, where our stand is against the consumption of alcohol and drugs inside the campus premises.
3. Our demand is the disbursement of contingency of Rs. 10,000 to all the Non-NET fellowship holders.
4. Our demand is the development of a Central Instrumentation Facility in the University and purchase of sophisticated instruments for research.
5. Our demand is increasing the number of women security guards and to ensure the security to all the people inside the University and the activation of a 24*7 emergency helpline number for providing support to the people in need.
6. Our demand is the monitoring of speed of vehicles inside the campus, after evening and the repair of the broken speed breakers and placement or removal of speed breakers across the campus for making the campus accessible for the people with disability.

DEPUTATION NO. 5:

Considered a deputation from Arts faculty Students' Union (AFSU) regarding Students' Union Election in Jadavpur University.

Contents of the Deputation:

Sir,

We have been demanding the Students' Union elections for a long time. On this issue we would demand a tripartite meeting of the Students' Authority & the Government, at the earliest. If the EC fails to declare a date for a tripartite meeting we would go for a sit in demonstration.

DEPUTATION NO. 6:

Considered a deputation from Jadavpur university Contractor's Worker's Union (AFSU) regarding various issues.

Contents of the Deputation:

মাননীয় মহাশয়/মহাশয়া,

আপনারা হয়ত অবগত আছেন যে যাদবপুর বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় কন্ট্রাক্টর্স ওয়ার্কার্স ইউনিয়ন বিগত প্রায় দশ মাস ধরে বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের চুক্তিবদ্ধ কর্মচারীদের বিভিন্ন সমস্যা নিয়ে আন্দোলন চালিয়ে আসছে। আমরা আপনাদেরকে জানাতে চাই যে এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের মধ্যেই কর্মরত কিছু কর্মচারী আছেন, বিশেষত যাঁরা জেনারেল মেইন্টেন্যান্স, গ্রীণ জোন এবং সল্ট লেক ক্যাম্পাসের ইলেক্ট্রিক্যাল মেইন্টেন্যান্সে কাজ করেন, তাঁরা বিভিন্ন কারণে বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের ম্যানপাওয়ার এজেন্সির অন্তর্ভুক্ত নন। কেউ কেউ AMC, আবার কেউ কেউ জব কন্ট্রাক্টের অধীনে কাজ করলেও মূলত এনাদের কাজের প্রকৃতি এবং কাজের সময় ও পদ্ধতি ম্যানপাওয়ার এজেন্সিতে কর্মরত কর্মীদের মতই।

বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ে বহু বছর, কিছু কিছু ক্ষেত্রে কয়েক দশক ধরে কাজ করে আসা এই সমস্ত কর্মীদের অনেকেরই ইএসআই-পিএফের সুবিধাটুকু নেই, কারো কারো ন্যূনতম বেতনের অধিকার নেই, অনেকের ক্ষেত্রেই বেতন আসে অনিয়মিত। এমনকি এই কর্মীদেরকে বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় কর্তৃপক্ষ তাঁদের নিজস্ব কর্মচারী হিসেবে মান্যতাও দেয় না। পুজোর আগে এই বিষয়ে রেজিস্ট্রারের অফিস থেকে একটি নোটিফিকেশন বেরোলেও তার সুফল এখনও পাননি এই কর্মীরা।

আমরা দীর্ঘদিন ধরেই জানিয়ে আসছি বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের অভ্যন্তরে কর্মরত জেনারেল মেইন্টেন্যান্স, গ্রীন জোন ও সল্টলেক ক্যাম্পাসের ইলেক্ট্রিক্যাল মেইন্টেন্যান্সে কর্মরত এই সমস্ত কর্মচারীদেরকে ম্যানপাওয়ার এজেন্সির অন্তর্ভুক্ত করার, কিন্তু বিভিন্ন মিটিংএ আমাদের জানানো হয়েছে এই বিষয়টি বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের পলিসিগত সিদ্ধান্ত। তাই আজ আমরা বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের সর্বোচ্চ নীতি নির্ধারক কমিটির কাছে আবেদন রাখছি এই কর্মচারীদেরকে অবিলম্বে ম্যানপাওয়ার এজেন্সির অন্তর্ভুক্ত করার, অন্যথায় আগামী দিনে আমরা এই বিষয়ে তীব্র আন্দোলনে নামতে বাধ্য হব।

The immediate occasion for my proposal was the urgent need to enable researchers worldwide to access the archives that have been generated in the Department of History, Jadavpur University, over a period of 13 years; indeed our archival efforts are still ongoing and we have many more projects on the anvil. (A list of archives already generated in the department, under my supervision, is attached).</p> <p>The following points may be emphasised in this regard, recalling our conversation of 13.10.2022:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. This membership shall not involve any financial commitment on the part of Jadavpur University. The university shall contribute to SAOA strictly in-kind that is in the form of digital volumes and the requisite staff time. 2. If the university decides to become a member of SAOA, then an institutional representative needs to be nominated by the university as a voting member of SAOA on behalf of Jadavpur University. 3. The digital materials uploaded on the SAOA database and disseminated worldwide through JSTOR will also be preserved in two separate copies - one at the department of History and another at the Central Library, Jadavpur University. <p>Kindly note that Ms Elizabeth Lhost, the South Asia Digital Librarian at Centre for Research Libraries and member of SAOA Executive Board, has expressed her eagerness regarding Jadavpur University's joining as a contributing (in-kind) member of SAOA. (A copy of her email is attached)</p> <p>I, therefore, earnestly request you to kindly initiate the procedure whereby Jadavpur University can become a member of the South Asia Open Archives, enabling the Department of History to upload their archives on this open access platform.</p>
